DDPM reporting 227 death toll in 28 provinces national wide

November 16, 2010

Department of Disaster Prevention and Mitigation (DDPM) reported the present flood situation as of November 15, 2010, 227 death tolls in 28 provinces. It is divided in to 4 regions as the followings; 77 casualties in Central, 72 casualties in Southern, 50 casualties in Northeastern, 25 casualties in North and 3 casualties in Eastern Part. Accordingly, DDPM with the collaboration of DDPM Provincial Office to provide victim compensation from Ministry of Finance's regulation and Prime Minister Office Fund.

Mr.Wiboon Sanguanpong, Director General of Disaster Prevention and Mitigation stated that due to heavy rain caused severe flood in many areas, 224 casualties in 28 provinces as the followings region;

Central Region, 77 casualties

Lopburi (18), Saraburi (4), Chainart (6), Nonthaburi (7), Suphanburi (8), Pathumthani (3), Pranakorn Si Ayutthaya (21) and Singburi Province (10)

Southern Region, 72 casualties

Songkla (35), Satun (2), Surat Thani (7), Pattani (5), Phattalung (7), Chumporn (2), Trang (4) and Nakhon Si Thammarat Province (10)

Northeastern Region, 50 casualties

Nakhonratchasima (32), Buriram (6), Khon Kaen (5) and Chaiyaphum Province (7)

North Region, 25 casualties

Nakhonsawan (15), Uthaithani (1), Kampangetch (6), Pichit (1) and Petchabun Province (2)

East Region, 3 casualties

Rayong (1), Trad (1), Srakaew (1)

Most dead from various causes such as 196 drowning, 15 electrocute, 6 from landslide, 2 fallen trees, 2 flashflood to vehicle, 2 fainted/ unconscious, 2 crashes, 1 boat capsized, 1 from fire and 1 from lack of oxygen.
