DDPM reporting 16 districts 85 districts stills flood

November 18, 2010

Department of Disaster Prevention and Mitigation (DDPM) reports present flood situation as of November 18, 2010, 51 provinces, 546 districts, 3,877 sub-districts, 31,716 villages, 2,523,608 households, 8,663,211 people affected. While 35 provinces are getting improved. Flood is still existing in 16 provinces, 85 districts, 658 sub-districts, 4,959 villages, 396,090 households, 1,303,208 people, 229 dead. Therefore, it is divided into 4 regions as the followings;

Northeast and Central Region

12 provinces, 40 districts, 334 sub-districts, 2,159 villages, 185,884 households, 631,110 people, 6,316,156 rai of farmland ruined and 156 dead in Srisaket, Khon Kaen, Mahasarakham, Ubonratchathani, Roi Et, Chainart, Suphanburi, Phra Nakhon Si Ayutthaya, Saraburi, Nonthaburi and Pathumthani province.

South Region

4 provinces, 45 districts, 324 sub-districts, 2,800 villages, 210,206 households, 672,098 people affected and 73 dead in Songkla, Surat Thani, Nakhon Si Thammarat and Phattalung Province.

35 provinces are getting improved namely; Pichit, Petchabun, Rayong, Chantaburi, Trad, Tak, Chonburi, Lamphun, Chiang Mai, Srakaew, Nakhonnayok, Kamphangpetch, Pitsanuloke, Nongbualampu, Prachinburi, Samutprakarn, Nakhonpathom, Uthai Thani, Buriram, Chasoengsao, Angthong, Chaiyaphum, Nakhonsawan, Nakhonratchasima, Lopburi, Singburi, Surin, Satun, Narathiwat, Yala, Krabi, Chumporn, Ranong, Pattani and Trang province.
