14 provinces are still flood and dead toll reaches 241

November 23, 2010

Mr. Wiboon Sanguanpong, Director General of Department of Disaster Prevention and Mitigation states overview flood situation since October 10, 2010 - at present that 51 provinces, 550 districts, 3,894 sub districts, 31,870 villages, 2,526,346 households, 8,667,192 people affected, while 37 provinces are under recovery stage. Nowadays, 14 provinces, 60 districts, 487 sub-districts, 3,242 villages, 277,645 households, 908,133 people affected and dead toll reached 241.

It is divided to 2 areas as the followings; 10 provinces in northeast and central region, 31 districts, 267 sub-districts, 1,780 villages, 159,942 households, 533,695 people affected and 6,316,156 rai of farmland destroyed, 163 dead. Flood is existing in Srisaket, Khon Kaen, Kalasin, Mahasarakham, Ubonratchathani, Roi Et, Suphanburi, Pra Nakhon Si Ayutthaya, Nonburi and Pathumthani Province.

While 4 provinces in south region, 29 districts, 220 sub-districts, 1,462 villages, 117,703 households, 374,438 people affected and 78 dead in Songkla, Surat Thani, Nakhon Si Thammarat and Phattalung Province.

Furtherly 37 provinces are under recovery stage namely; Pichit, Petchabun, Rayong, Chantaburi, Trad, Tak, Chonburi, Lamphun, Chiang Mai, Srakaew, Nakhonnayok, Kampangetch, Pitsanuloke, Nongbualampu, Prachinburi, Samutprakarn, Nakhonpathom, Uthai Thani, Chaeongsao, Angthong, Chaiyaphum, Nakhonsawan, Nakhonratchasima, Lopburi, Singburi, Surin, Satun, Narathiwat, Yala, Krabi, Chumporn, Ranong, Pattani, Trang, Saraburi and Chainart Province
