### DDPM reports 14 provinces still flood and dead toll reaches 241

November 23, 2010

Ministry of Interior by Department of Disaster Prevention and Mitigation (DDPM) updates current flood situation as of November 23, 2010, 51 total affected provinces while 37 provinces are getting improved. Presently, 14 provinces, 60 districts, 487 sub-districts, 3,242 villages, 277,645 households, 908,133 people and 241 dead toll nationwide affected from flood. It is divided into 6 northeast region provinces in namely; Srisaket, Khon Kean, Kalasin, Mahasarakham, Ubonratchathani and Roi Et province, 4 central region provinces namely; Suphanburi, Pra Nakorn Si Ayutthaya, Nonthaburi and Pathumthani province and 4 south region provinces namely; Songkla, Surat Thani, Nakhon Si Thammarat and Phattalung province.

Mr. Wiboon Sanguanpong, Director General of Disaster Prevention and Mitigation stated current flood situation from October 10 to at present, the entire disaster areas covered 51 provinces, 550 districts, 3,894 sub-districts, 31,870 villages, 2,526,346 households, 8,667,192 people.

Whereas, 37 provinces were getting improved. Nowadays, 14 provinces, 60 districts, 487 sub-districts, 3,242 villages, 277,645 households, 908,133 people and 241 casualties as the following details;

Flood situation in Northeast, East and Central Region caused 39 provinces, 417 districts, 3,038 sub-districts, 25,879 villages, 1,978, 088 households and 6,934,719 people, 163 dead.

Currently, 29 provinces are getting improved namely; Pichit, Petchabun, Rayong, Chantaburi, Trad, Tak, Chonburi, Lamphun, Chiang Mai, Srakaew, Nakhonnayok, Kampangeth, Phitsanulok, Nongbualampu, Prachinburi, Samutprakarn, Nakhonpathom, Uthaitani, Buriram, Chasoengsao, Angthong, Chaiyaphum, Nakhonsawan, Nakhonratchasima, Lopburi, Singburi, Surin Chainart and Saraburi Province. Nowadays 10 provinces, 31 districts, 267 sub-districts, 1,780 villages, 155,942 household, 533,695 people affected, including the approximately damaged farmland in total around 6,316,156 rai. The death toll reaches 163 people and divided into 6 northeastern Provinces namely; Srisaket, Khon Kaen, Kalasin, Mahasarakham, Ubonratchathani and Roi Et Province and 4 central provinces namely; Suphanburi, Pra Nakhon Si Ayutthaya, Nonthaburi and Pathumthani Province.

While the flood situation occurred in 12 provinces, 133 districts, 856 sub-districts, 5,991 villages, 548,258 households, 1,732,473 people were affected. 8 provinces are getting improved namely ;Satun, Narathiwat, Yala, Krabi, Chumporn, Ranong, Pattani and Trang. Whereas 4

provinces, 29 districts, 220 sub-districts, 1,462 villages, 117,703 households, 374,438 people and total **dead toll reaches 78**.

It is also divided into 4 regions as the following:

### **6 Northeastern Region Provinces;**

**Sirsaket Province;** 5 districts, 22 sub-districts, 96 villages, 9,271 households, 40,672 people affected in Rasisalai, Kantararom, Silalad, Yanchumnoi and Bungboon district

**Khon Kaen Province;** 1 districts, 4 sub-districts, 32 villages, 211 households, 1,017 people affected in Ubonrat district

**Kalasin Province ;** 2 districts, 3 sub-districts, 11 villages, 48 households, 166 people affected including 43,964 rai of farmland ruined from flood in Klongchai and Kamalasai district.

**Maharakham Province,** according to inundation from Chi River caused 3 districts, 30 sub-districts, 407 villages, 17,726 households, 42,528 people affected in Muang, Kosumpisai and Katarakwichai district

**Ubonratchathani Province;** 2 districts, 2 municipalities, 29 villages, 1,610 households, 5,373 people effected in Muang and Warinchamrap district

**Roi Et Province** an inundation from Shi River 3 districts, 8 sub-districts, 34 villages, 905 households, 2,738 people effected and 39,822.50 rai of farmland ruined from flood in Janghan, Ponsai and Chiangkwan district.

### **4 Central Province;**

**Suphanburi Province;** 2 districts, 28 sub-districts, 264 villages, 21,300 households, 63,900 people affected in Bangplama, and Songpeenong district

**Phra Nakhon Si Ayutthaya Province;** 9 districts, 124 sub-districts, 813 villages, 78,344 households, 243,361 people affected in Bangsai, Maharat, Pakhai, Bangban, Sena, Bang Pa In, Bang Pa Han, Ladbualuang and Bangsai district

**Nonthaburi Province ;** 2 districts, 27 sub-districts, 44 villages, 15,027 households, 71,940 people affected in Muang, Pakkred, Bankrauy, Bangyai, Bangbuathong and Sainoi district

**Pathumthani Province;** 2 districts, 19 sub-districts, 2 municipalities, 50 villages, 15,500 households, 62,000 people affected in Muang and Samkok district

### **4 Southern Region;**

**Songkha Province;** 5 districts, 42 sub-districts, 309 villages, 47,320 households, 144,841 people affected and 202,499 rai of farmland ruined in 5 districts namely; Kuanniang, Satingpra, Ranode, Singhanakorn and Kasaesin district.

**Surat Thani;** 6 districts, 42 sub-districts, 291 villages, 29,878 households, 96,494 people affected namely Punpin, Tachang, Bannadern, Wipawadee, Bannasan, and Thachana district.

**Nakhon Si Thammarat;** 13 districts, 96 sub-districts, 432 villages, 11,063 households, 38,477 people affected in Muang, Huasai, Lansaka, Sichon, Pipoon, Choad, Kanom, Nobpitam, Ronpiboon, Chulaporn, Thasala, Tampanna, Changklang, Pakpanang, Praprom, Promkiri, Chalermprakiet, , and Chienyai district. In addition the farmland expected to be destroyed around 263,009 rai.

**Phattalung;** 5 districts, 40 sub-districts, 430 villages, 29,442 households, 94,626 effected people. Besides, the effected farmland was approximately 482,330 rai, in Muang, Khaochaison, Kuankanun, Pakpayoon and Bangkaew district.

DDPM Regional Center 11 and 12 with collaboration with concerned agencies such as military, Thai Red Cross, Volunteer and Foundation provided more than 2,000 rescue boats, 500,000 relief kits, 4,600 tents, 17 drinking water production trucks, 400, 000 drinking water bottles, 400 water pumps, 700 mobile rescue units, 15 lighting trucks, 4 million sand bags, 33,000 medicines, 700 clothes, 7,158 mobile toilets and 2,800 officers to alleviate victims.

Furtherly, DDPM dispatched damage assessment officials to accelerate victim compensation according to Ministry of Finance Regulation.
