10 provinces still flood and 244 dead

November 25, 2010

Mr. Wiboon Sanguanpong, Director General of Department of Disaster Prevention and Mitigation (DDPM) stated flood situation from October 10, 2010 to at present 51 total affected provinces, 550 districts, 3,894 sub-districts, 31,870 villages, 2,526,346 households, 8,667,192 people. While 41 provinces are getting improved. Presently, 10 provinces, 36 districts, 288 sub-districts, 1,809 villages, 188,175 households, 637,330 people and 244 dead toll nationwide affected from flood.

It is divided into 8 northeast and central region provinces, 27 districts, 215 sub-districts, 1,186 villages, 129,855 households, 452,710 people affected, death toll reached 166. Flood still exists in Kalasin, Roi Et, Srisaket, Ubonratchathani, Suphanburi, Pra Nakorn Si Ayutthaya, Nonthaburi and Pathumthani province.

Additionally, 2 south region provinces, 73 sub-districts, 641 villages, 58,320 households, 184,620 people affected and 78 people died. Flood still exists in Surat Thani, and Phattalung province.

Whereas, 41 provinces were getting improved namely; Lamphun, Chaing Mai, Kampangetch, Pitsanuloke, Pichit, Petchabun, Uthaithani, Chainart, Chaiyaphum, Nakhonsawan, Khon Kaen, Mahasarakham, Nongbualamphu, Surin, Nakhonratchasima, Rayong, Chantaburi, Trad, Tak, Chonburi, Srakaew, Saraburi, Nakhonnayok, Prachinburi, Samutprakarn, Nakhonpathom, Buriram, Chuseongsao, Anghong, Lopburi, Singburi, Songkla, Nakhon Si Thammarat, Satun, Narathiwat, Yala, Krabi, Chumporn, Ranong, Pattani and Trang.
