**\*Facts about Cold Weather Situation In Thailand:**

According to criteria set by The Department of Disaster Prevention and Mitigation (DDPM) for disaster declaration due to cold weather, the provinces can declare disaster when the 7-day weather forecast of the Thai Meteorological Department (TMD) indicates the areas' temperature lower than 15.9 C.
